Post Racing Incentive Program

The Ontario Quarter Horse Racing Industry Development Program (QHRIDP) Post Racing Incentive Program supports the market for Quarter Horses after their racing careers in Ontario by encouraging the purchase of retired racehorses for other equestrian sports.

How It Works:

- Partner Associations promote and host recognized events.
- Quarter Horses that have raced in Ontario earn points competing in those recognized events. Horses earn one point per completed run or class.
- Owners of Quarter Horses that have raced in Ontario complete an application for the Post Racing Incentive which includes the Certificate of Registration and proof that the horse raced in Ontario. Applications are due annually by November 30.
- Representatives of the Partner Associations verify participation.
- Owners receive a **Post Racing Incentive payment** based on the total competition points earned by their eligible Quarter Horses at recognized events.

A total of \$20,000 is available, with a maximum payment of \$1,500 per eligible horse.

- Partner Associations receive a \$500 payment for promoting the program, verifying participation and identifying a High-Point Post Racing Incentive horse. The High-Point Post Racing Incentive horse from each Partner Association will receive an additional payment of \$100.

Ontario's Post Racing Incentive Program

- Adds value to Quarter Horses that have raced in Ontario
- Provides an incentive for people to purchase Quarter Horses at the conclusion of their racing careers
- Provides retired racehorses with new opportunities in equestrian sports

How to Participate:

The **owner** of an eligible horse, as listed on the AQHA Certificate of Registration, is eligible to receive the incentive. Applications are due annually by November 30.

To apply, submit the following:

- A completed application form, verified by the Partner Association representative. Application forms are available from the Partner Association, on the Quarter Horse Page at ontarioracing.com or by contacting the Program Administrator at qhprogram@ontarioracing.com
- The horse's AQHA Certificate of Registration, showing the current owner-of-record.
- Proof that the horse raced in Ontario.

How Earnings Are Determined

Horses earn one point per completed run or class at a recognized event.

Points are tallied, and the total available incentive is divided by the total points earned to determine the per point value. Incentives are calculated as:

Total Amount Available for Incentives

$$\div \text{Total points Earned} = \text{Per Point Value}$$

Points Earned Per Horse

$$\times \text{Per Point Value} = \text{Incentive Payment}$$

(maximum \$1,500 per horse)

Partner Associations are responsible for naming one horse as "High Point Post Racing Incentive Horse" and that horse will receive an additional \$100.



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
